


When you think about it, your garage is an extension of your home, and it should not be treated much differently from any other room, particularly if the garage is attached to your property. The garage door is often seen as a weak link in the thermal envelope on any home, so choosing an insulated garage door will help to prevent the cold outside air from penetrating into your garage and surrounding living spaces.

Insulation

The CFC-free, foam-filled aluminium slats used in SeceuroGlide garage doors maximise the energy performance of the door, helping to retain heat within the garage and closing off the cold from outside. Insulated slats also boast noise-reducing properties – perfect if your garage is used as a hobby room or workshop. A typical U-value for the slat profiles used on an insulated roller garage door is 5.2 W / m²K.

Lighting

SeceuroGlide lighting options provide the opportunity to have attractive outside lighting. Discreetly fitted as a down light this enhancement to your garage can be programmed to turn on and off automatically in accordance with when you use your garage, or can be left on to allow additional lighting to your outside area, for up to 12 hours. The SeceuroGlide Plus control unit benefits from a built-in courtesy light, helping to light up the inside of your garage.





The SeceuroGlide Compact uses an insulated 55 mm aluminium slat that is significantly narrower than those featured on the SeceuroGlide Original. This allows a tighter, smaller coil requiring just 8" (205 mm) of headroom, giving owners of even the smallest garages the option of a high quality remote controlled door.

Extremely versatile, a SeceuroGlide Compact door can be fitted in-front of or behind the garage opening, or even (height permitting) within the garage opening itself. An extensive range of sizes also means openings of up to 2880 mm wide can be accommodated, whilst a neat 90° fascia conceals the coil back. There is also an optional 45° canopy to completely enclose the coil.





Vision slats allow natural light into your garage. On woodgrain doors vision slats will be supplied in a brown finish.

Vented slats

(SeceuroGlide Original only)

Vented slats allow good air circulation which is especially useful if you have laundry facilities in your garage and during the summer months. Vented slats are located at the very bottom of the door, above the bottom slat.

Remote control keypad

(SeceuroGlide Original and SeceuroGlide Compact only)

The remote control key pad provides you with a secure, alternative option for controlling your door. Suitable for external installation, this wireless controller offers convenience without compromising security.

Powder coated end plates

When you order a half or full box enjoy complimentary powder coated end plates to ensure your door is fully matched. Plus, when you choose one of our woodgrain colours this is complimentary regardless of box choice and will be done in a colour closely resembling your door.

Full box

A full box completely conceals the roll. This option allows SeceuroGlide Original, LT and SeceuroGlide Compact doors to be fitted outside the garage. Boxes are supplied in white or brown as standard. They can also be supplied in any of the plain colour finishes for an additional surcharge.

Low level external override kit

(SeceuroGlide Original, LT and SeceuroGlide Compact only)

The low level external override kit enables the door to be opened manually in emergencies from both the inside and outside of the garage. If the garage door is the only means of entry you will require a low level external override kit.



Important Information

Colours & Finishes

- The printing process does not allow exact reproduction of the paint colours. If you are unsure of your colour choice please ask your supplier for a sample. Colour references quoted are the nearest standard RAL or BS number to the colours used. They will not be an exact match and are intended as a quide only.
- Multiple doors should be ordered together to obtain the best colour match, bearing in mind the limitations of the materials used in construction.
- Due to the manufacturing process the guide rails may not be an exact match to the slat colour. The manufacturing process for the slat profile results in a textured finish while all other coloured items (guide rails, bottom slats, end plates, optional fascias and vision panels) are supplied in a smooth finish so we cannot guarantee an exact match.
- When Painted Woodgrains are supplied with a colour matched box, end plates and guides, the following RAL are used: Golden Oak RAL 8003, Irish Oak RAL 1011, Rosewood RAL 8017.
- Foiled Woodgrains (Anthracite, Black/Brown, Golden Oak, Irish Oak, Mahogany, Rosewood and White) are subject to a surcharge.
- Where the curtain is powder coated a custom colour, the guide rails, bottom slats, optional fascias, vision panels and end plates will be powder coated to match FOC. Some custom powder coated colours may be subject to an additional surcharge.
- Custom colour powder coated garage doors are finished in a low gloss finish which is similar in gloss level to the precoated colours.
- Due to the powder coating process, an un-painted area of each slat is visible on the quirk when the door is opening/closing. This should not be visible when the door is in the closed position. To mitigate this, we recommend purchasing powder coated doors with a full box or 45° box cover.
- The factory application of the paint finish involves an automated process and this may result in minor blemishes or slight inconsistencies in the paint.
- We recommend that you perform a visual quality check on installation. Carry out the quality check in natural daylight, not direct sunlight. Stand at a distance of 3 metres from the product to view the overall appearance.
- The product is acceptable if, taking into account the facts below, none of the following is readily visible on the face of the product:
 - Marks or distortions associated with the manufacturing process
 - Minor indentations, marks or scuffs on the surface
 - Paint or stain blemishes
- While weathering and sun exposure can cause the exterior surface to fade, colour change or fade will be limited and uniform.

Product Care

- Correct operation and care of your SeceuroGlide door in accordance with the official Operating & Maintenance Manual will prolong the life of your door and minimise the likelihood of issues.
- The door needs wiping with a damp cloth and a mild detergent to remove any excessive dirt/grime to maintain its appearance and to reduce the risk of the surface being damaged.
- Floor must be smooth, level and kept clear of dirt and debris, which can cause deterioration of the rubber seal.

Extreme Weather Conditions

- High winds and high temperatures on double doors can cause increased deflection of the door. It is the installer's responsibility to ensure that the door is spaced off the wall sufficiently to allow for door movement during these extreme weather conditions.
- Darker coloured double doors that are exposed to significant direct sunlight may be susceptible to expansion which may interfere with the operation of the door.
- If a door is situated in an exposed location and subjected to very high winds and driving rain, the SeceuroGlide range does not guarantee against water ingress. As part of the product's testing for the CE or UKCA marking, the product has not been tested against this and as such is classified as NPD (No Performance Declared).
- Whilst the garage door profiles are primed and coated for the external environment – any doors fitted in coastal environments may be at risk of deterioration due to the weather conditions.
- Regular cleaning of products in 'high corrosive areas' such as within 2 miles of the sea is especially important. Your door should be cleaned thoroughly weekly using warm water and mild detergent with a soft cloth or sponge. Allow to dry naturally. Never use strong detergent, abrasive, caustic or solvent-based cleaners.
- In the event of extreme weather conditions, vision slats will be susceptible to water ingress and may cause the door to move in extreme gales.

Marking

The nature of roller garage doors means marking may appear on the internal side of the slats over time. Occasionally some marking may occur at the top of the concave (coil) side of the curtain over time, particularly on the Compact and LT. This is unavoidable and due to prolonged contact with the locking system. On doors which are installed externally this will be visible on the outside.

Warranty Conditions

- The SeceuroGlide warranty covers <u>parts only</u> and does not cover labour costs or consequential costs, including but not limited to call-out fees, transport costs and costs remedial work for removing and/or re-installing faulty parts.
- SWS UK will replace or repair any components of our products where the manufacturing process has resulted in a defect occurring during the relevant period, subject to the exceptions and conditions set out below.
- For all replacement electrical parts, the warranty period is 12 months or the remainder of the warranty period (whichever is the longest).

The warranty does not cover the following:

- Any marks, distortion, stains, blemishes, indentations or scuffs which are not observable from at least 3 metres away in natural light (not direct sunlight).
- X Defects which are as a result of:
 - Incorrect installation of the product, not following SWS UK's installation instructions.
 - Incorrect or lack of proper care and maintenance of the product in accordance with SWS UK's Operating & Maintenance Manual.
 - Incorrect operation of the product.
 - Any modifications made to the product made by anyone other than SWS UK.
 - Normal wear and tear.
 - Accidental or malicious damage.
 - Impact damage or scratches, dents, scuffs or other minor abrasions.
 - Use or attempted use of non-SWS UK spare parts.
 - Repairs or attempts at repairs undertaken by any person other than someone specifically authorised by SWS UK.
 - Any failure of masonry or other structures on to which the product has been fixed.
 - Any attempt to reduce operating clearances by means of infills or draughtproofing.
 - External influences such as extreme or abnormal weather conditions, fire, water, salts, chemicals and bird droppings.
 - Any fault or surge in the customer's electricity.
- X Rust or corrosion caused by exposure to saltwater or salty air for products installed within 500 metres of the sea or a large body of saltwater. For products installed within 2 miles of the sea, the exterior finish of the product is guaranteed for a limited period of 2 years.
- **X** Consumables such as fuses, light bulbs or batteries.
- Indirect, special or consequential loss or damage howsoever caused, including remedial work costs, call-out fees, tool or plant hire and transport costs.

Warranties

SeceuroGlide Roller Garage Doors are guaranteed against defect of material or workmanship by SWS UK with a parts only warranty, subject to correct installation, maintenance and operation:

- Curtain finish
 - Standard colours 5 years
 - Painted woodgrains 5 years
 - Foiled woodgrains 10 years
- Mechanism & hardware 5 years
- Perishable rubber parts 2 years
- Motor & control unit 5 years, or 7 years when you purchase a SeceuroDrive motor with a SeceuroSense Plus control unit OR a Somfy motor with a Somfy Rollixo control unit (subject to online warranty registration within 3 months of installation) - excludes the LT.

Register Your Warranty

You must register your warranty at www.seceuroglide.co.uk to activate your extended product guarantee. It takes just a few moments and also gives you easier access to maintenance and operation information, spare parts and warranty claims.

Regular Servicing

To ensure the longevity and continued good operation of your SeceuroGlide garage door, it is recommended that your door is serviced every 12 months by a trained engineer. You may be required to show a full service record for the product when raising a warranty claim.

The importance of conformity with CE and UKCA marking.

It is against the law to install a power operated garage door in the UK without complying with The Machinery Directive.

To comply with the Machinery Directive both the door and the motor and controller used in the installation must have a Declaration of Incorporation from the manufacturer.

On completion of the installation the installer must provide a Declaration of Conformity and apply a CE or UKCA mark giving details of the installation to the door / motor and controller combination, which is now classed as a machine.

The installer must issue to the customer a Declaration of Conformity and Operating and Maintenance instructions on the completion of the installation.

The installer must hold copies of both the Declaration of Incorporation and the Declaration of Conformity on a technical file for inspection by the relevant authorities.

If any of the above requirements are not fulfilled the Installation is illegal.

Please ensure for your own safety and peace of mind that whoever installs your electric motor and controller is both willing and able to fulfil these requirements; if they are not – do not use them.
